Cllr Wanstall explained how registering The Sportsman as an ACV worked. It was noted by Cllr Marsh that the owner has right of appeal to the council’s decision if granted but if not granted, the nominator does not. Cllr Wanstall noted that seeking listed building status should be considered. Cllr Robbins added that from discussions with officers at DDC, the future of The Sportsman is unknown but it is unlikely to be used as a pub.
